Overview

iWATCH is a nationwide modern version of Neighborhood Watch developed by the Los Angeles Police Department to encourage and enable members of the community in identifying and reporting suspicious behavior that may be associated with terrorist activities.

Overview

iWATCH quickly spread across the United States and the concept was adopted by the federal government and law enforcement agencies across the country. The United States Army was no exception.

This nationwide campaign creates partnerships between military and civilian organizations. Particularly in information sharing. Such information or cooperation may reveal a piece of the puzzle that thwarts a terrorist plot.

Consequently, iWATCH empowers Soldiers, civilian employees, contractors, their family members, as well as civilian visitors live play with protecting places where they live, work and play.

What is Suspicious Activity or Behavior?

Answers

1. Causing you to feel that something is wrong or that someone is behaving improperly; causing suspicion.
2. Having or showing a feeling that something is wrong or that someone is behaving improperly; feeling or showing suspicion.

Identifying suspicious activity or behaviors is not a difficult science. Rely on your judgment. Your suspicion of a threat could be confirmed with only one incident or it could take a series of incidents. Your suspicions will need to be based on:

Reporting Suspicious Activity



How would you describe a person or a vehicle?

For the individual pictured at left:

- Caucasian male; about 5'7", 160-180 lbs.
- Straight dark brown hair—to the bottom of the ears on the sides and collar-length in the back, bangs to the eyebrows; full moustache;
- Average build with thick neck; thick lower lip
- No noticeable scars, tattoos or disabilities - eye color unknown, wearing sunglasses; - wearing blue jacket, long dark blue or black chino pants, and new-looking white sneakers; large camera hanging around his neck

For the vehicle pictured at left:

- Blue Chevy Astro van; silver splash guard around bottom
- Pennsylvania license plate number FJ 6381
- Rust spots and discoloration on the back left door panel; rust above the back left wheel
- White bumper sticker with red lettering on back left side of the bumper

See something, say something

Terrorists are very sneaky. They are trying to hurt us. Sometimes they succeed. But they don't have to. Not if you keep your eyes open. If you see something unusual, tell a parent, a teacher or a friend.

Always Ready, Always Alert
Because someone is depending on you

What do you do if you see something suspicious?

- **DON'T** confront!
- **DO** get good descriptions of the individuals, vehicles and activities.
- **DO** immediately report the activity to the Police.

Timely and Accurate Reporting is the Key



iWATCH ARMY



There are two elements to iWATCH:
Passive and ***Active***.

The ***Passive*** element of iWATCH is individual situational awareness of your surroundings.

The ***Active*** element requires individuals to take action and report suspicious behavior or activities, to law enforcement for further investigation.

What Activities to Report?



PASSIVE ELEMENT -- Be aware of these suspicious activities:

- People drawing or measuring important buildings.
- Strangers asking questions about security forces or security procedures.
- A briefcase, suitcase, backpack or package left behind.
- Cars or trucks left in NO PARKING zones in front on important buildings.
- Intruders found in secure areas.
- A person wearing clothes that are too big and bulky and/or too hot for the weather.
- Chemical smells or fumes that worry you.
- Questions about sensitive information such as building blueprints, security plans or VIP travel schedules without a right or need to know.
- Purchasing supplies or equipment that can be used to make bombs or weapons or purchasing uniforms without having the proper credentials.

How to Report



ACTIVE ELEMENT --

- ✓ Report all suspicious persons and activities to the Redstone Dispatch at (256) 313-6422. If you are at work please notify your supervisor and Organizational ATO once you have called the proper authorities. NOTE: If any incident appears life threatening call 911 immediately.

- ✓ Provide as much of the following details:
 - 1) **WHO?** Describe who is involved in the suspicious activity such as: Male or Female? How Tall? Build? Hair Color? Skin Color? Age? English speaking or another language? NOTE if there is a car note the license plate number, vehicle make and model etc.
 - 2) **WHAT?** Describe what you witnessed.
 - 3) **WHERE?** Give the location of the suspicious activity (i.e. street address or name of the facility).
 - 4) **WHEN?** Give the date and time the activity took place.
 - 5) **WHY?** Indicate why the activity is suspicious to you or if you have seen this activity before.

Important Places to Watch

- Unit Headquarters
- Installation access points
- Sports/entertainment venues
- Recreation centers, fitness facilities
- Religious facilities
- Barracks, lodging facilities
- Large gatherings –parades, fairs, etc.
- Schools, libraries, day care centers
- Commissary, PX, gas stations, banks







Suspicious Vehicle Indicators

- Rental vehicles/trailers parked near a facility, parked at or near the loading dock, or located in the parking lot without prior notification.
- Appears to be overloaded or has any substance leaking from it.
- Is parked illegally or parked at an unusual location.
- Appears to be abandoned (e.g., inspection sticker expired or missing, registration plate expired or missing, etc).
- Vehicle passing by key area/areas multiple times (e.g. possible surveillance).

Example Situations

- *“I saw someone taking pictures of the main gate. I don’t want to get them in trouble. What should I do?”*

Unsure? Let the experts decide!

- *“I saw someone watching our office, and the next day my co-worker was asked a lot of questions about our building by someone else.”*

iWATCH Army App



iWATCH isn't a neighborhood program with a small group of volunteers roaming the streets with flashlights and radios. The iWATCH Mobile App is all the public needs to join Law Enforcement in fighting crime.

In addition to the previous methods you can submit tips, add images or video to your tip from almost any Smartphone or any PC. All tips, regardless of the source, are 100% anonymous. Check the mobile app store on your device.

With the new iWATCH Army App:

- Send an anonymous text, start a live chat
- Send a quick tip and/or up to three photos & video with text. (anonymous)
- Send A Complete Tip (the most detail possible). Send a crime tip photos video text descriptions info with photos, video, text, descriptions, suspect info, location and type of crime.



Free Download to Your Smartphone



- **What's in it for me?** Protects our nation from attackers, reduces crime, increases public safety for our friends and families.
- **How do I get started?** To download the app, call (256) 217-4390 from your smartphone. The system will talk you through the process and/or send you a link to download the app. You may also search for the app using the term iWatch Army or access from a personal computer iwatcharmy.getiwatch.com.



Citizens play an important role in safeguarding DOD facilities

- Many terrorist plots have been foiled since 9/11 by alert citizens.
- The app reflects the iWatch Army campaign that encourages citizens to “See Something, Say Something.”
- Citizens who make prompt, detailed reports can help prevent crimes/attacks around facilities.

App does not replace 911

- If there is an emergency situation, contact 911.
- The iWatch Army app is intended for non-emergency reporting of suspicious activity.
- Reports should be focused on behaviors, not appearance.
